


Hawking Class Homework Term 3 - 4

Continue to practise the 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 11 and 12 times tables. How quickly can you recall the facts in a random order?	Create a crossword or word search with a coastal theme. You may use the internet for research, but don't use an online tool to create your puzzle.	Create a short presentation for the class on coastlines in other parts of the world. Talk about aspects that particularly interest you, such as wildlife or threats to the environment.	Living by the sea! What would it be like to live by the sea? Write a description of a morning by the seaside, from the moment the sun rises.	Investigate photos/artwork of coasts/the sea to inspire your own picture - use paints, pastels, pencils or collage.	Design a new form of coastal defence. How does it work? How is it better than existing coastal defences?
Spelling: Please, please, please practise your weekly spellings at least 3 times.	Can you explore and explain natural coastal disasters? Waves, erosion, landslides. What causes these and what are we doing to protect our coastlines.	Research the work of the R.N.L.I. Design a poster to raise awareness of the work this charity does.	Using squared paper, design and make a 'Treasure Island' game. Integrate the use of coordinates into your game. Don't forget to write out a set of instructions!	Free Task – choose a task or activity of your choice. This could be topic related or not!	What is so special about the White Cliffs of Dover? Present your findings in any way you wish. You could consider geographical or historical significance.



Please select 1 homework task each week. You are more than welcome to do more than one task if you would like.

When you have completed a task, bring your homework book to school on Thursday and we will mark it. You can record the practical tasks in a number of ways: photograph, a comment from a parent, a written review of the task.
